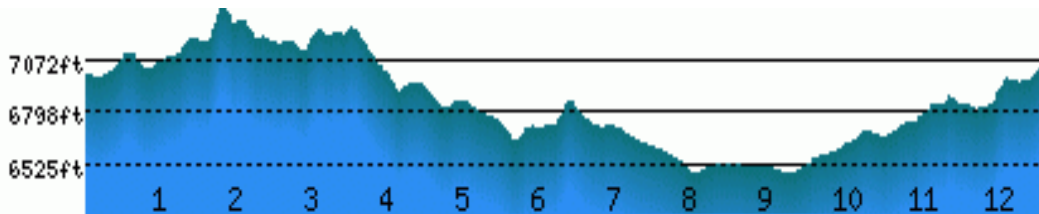

<b>Collegiate Team Time Trial (Point to Point ~20km)</b> Men (3 or 4 person) / Women (2 to 4 Person) Men timed on 3 <sup>rd</sup> rider, Women on 2 <sup>nd</sup> / 1 min intervals			
\$10 per person / 4 max	Start order: Collegiate Men's C, Women's B, Men's B, Women's A, Men's A	0700	Points
<b>Open Team Time Trial (Point to Point ~20km )</b> 2-Person Teams / Timed on 2 <sup>nd</sup> rider / 1 min intervals <b>You MUST race in the same category as the highest category ranking on your team.</b> <b>EXAMPLE: If you are a Cat 5 and your teammate is a Cat 2, then you are in the Pro 1/2/3 field.</b>

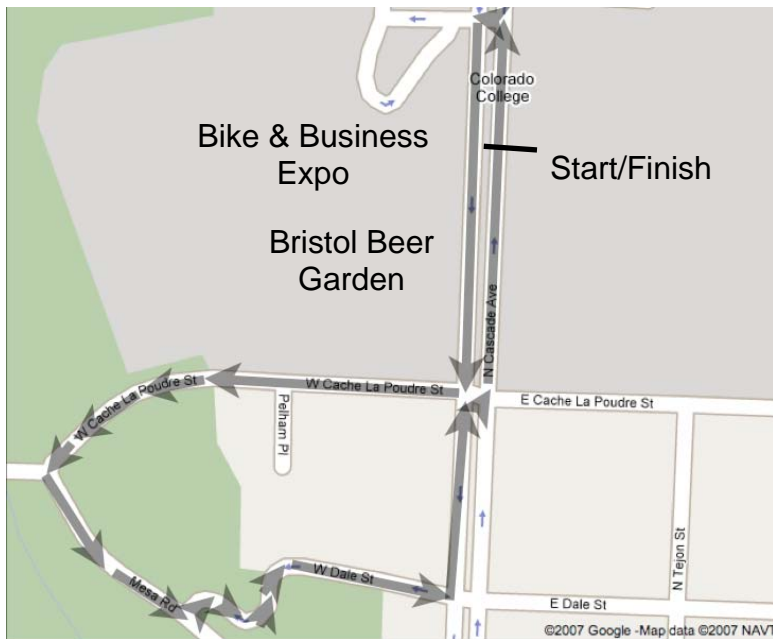

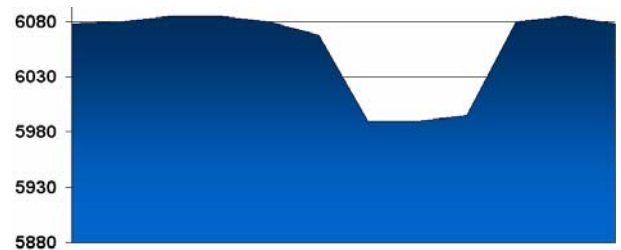

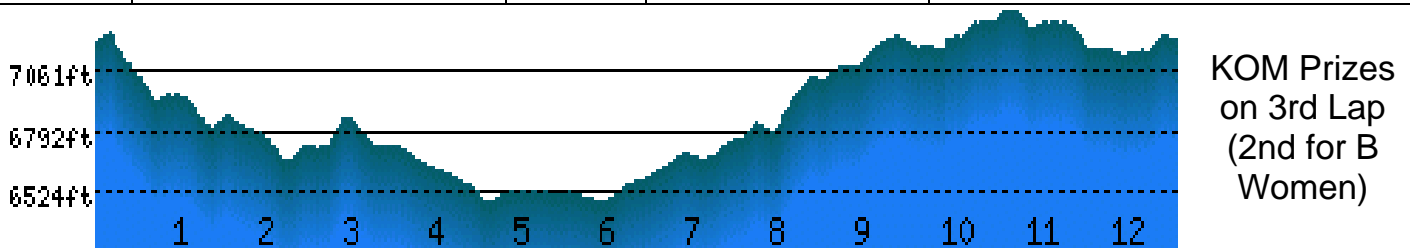

**Location:** 25 to Exit 150 (S. Gate/N. Academy). Turn west off exit towards mountains. Enter USAF Academy (will need ID), continue North on Stadium Blvd (over bridge and past stadium). Left at B52 Bomber on Academy Blvd (West, up hill). Pass overlooks on left, when road turns left after downhill, turn LEFT into parking/registration area.

**Course:** 12.75 mi, hilly, loop. 1986 Worlds course. Feed Zone on uphill by start/finish. Numbers on Right. Open to traffic. During race, you are in rolling enclosure. Off the back obey "rules of the road". Great road surface. 39x21 recommended

**Important Rules:** This is a federal installation; its use is at the discretion of the base commander. DO NOT urinate in public: use the porta-potties. DO NOT use foul language, You MUST carry an ID and wear your race number AT ALL times. Obey Base Security Police.

**This is your warning—cross the yellow line, you are disqualified!**
